Water Saving Tips:

- Fix leaks including toilets.
- Install high –efficiency toilets, aerators on bathroom faucets, and water-saver shower heads.
- Take shorter (5 minute) showers.
- Turn off water when brushing teeth or shaving.
- Use dishwasher and washing machine with full loads.
- Recycle indoor water to use on plants.
- Use broom to clean driveways, patios, and sidewalks instead of hose.
- Water plants/garden early in the day when cooler.
