Energy Saving Tips:

Program your thermostat-Set thermostat as low as comfortable in winter. For each degree you raise your thermostat setting, your fuel bill climbs 3%.

Maintain Filters-Regularly clean or replace your filters for your furnace. Make sure registers are not blocked by debris.

Add insulation-Wrap pipes and your water heater in insulation. This helps minimize heat loss.

Seal openings-Caulk and weather-strip around exterior seams, cracks, and openings.

Use Fans- Fans and ventilation systems can pull out a houseful of warm air in about an hour.

Adjust Drapes-Keep drapes open during day to allow sunlight to enter when cold. Close at night to reduce chill.
