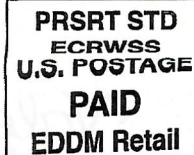

We are currently acquiring bids for street paving/repair from the Community Crossing Grant that we received last fall. We will start milling and repaving in the Spring.

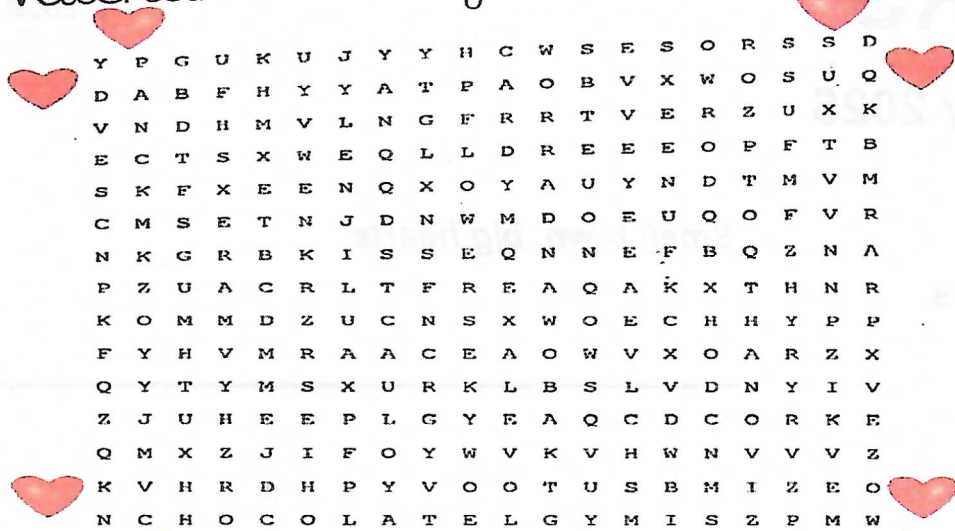
