Ice Cream in a Bag

Ingredients:

1 c Half and Half

2 tbsp granulated sugar

½ tsp vanilla

3 c Ice

1/3 c kosher salt

Step 1: in a small resealable bag combine half and half, sugar and vanilla. Remove air and seal.

Step 2: In a large resealable bag combine ice and salt. Place small bag inside big bag and shake vigorously for 7-10 minutes until ice cream has hardened.

Remove from bag and enjoy!

Town Updates:

Water Project-

The water project will be completed this week! Chalmers now has 3 (three) working wells and the new generator is being installed at the water plant. The old generator was moved to the Town Garage to utilized in case of a power outage and shelter during and emergency. This will allow the town to continue daily business without any disruption of service.

Streets and Sidewalks-

The Town Council is currently working on securing a matching grant to start paving streets. This money will be used for pave/repair roads and sidewalks. We should find out more if we are awarded the grant in August and should start paving in September. Hopefully we will be able to do two rounds of paving next year as well.
